SUMMARY: This template file provides essential information on how to prepare and submit Abstract to the RENEWABLE ENERGY 2026 INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE. Please follow them as precisely as possible. **The deadline of the submission of the abstract is END of JULY, 2026. Abstracts are specified to two (2) A4-pages and 2 MB max in a file size** regardless of oral or poster presentation. The title is in bold capital letters and centered at the top of the first page. It must be followed by the author(s) name(s), organization(s). Leave one bank line between the title and the name of the author(s). When several authors prepare a paper, the name of the presenter should be underlined. The name of each one's organization should be easily distinguished. Type a summary of your abstract in less than 10 lines, followed by the keywords up to 5 words.

Keywords: renewable energy, solar energy, wind power, manuscript, paper size (up to 5 words)

INTRODUCTION

In order to complete your abstract, replace all parts of this text with your presentation without changing any layout (font type and size, line spacing, page margins and so on). DO NOT insert page numbers or page headers/footers. **Papers not meeting these guidelines may be excluded from the conference abstracts.** These instructions have been formatted in the manner in which you should prepare your manuscript, thus you may use this document as an example.

The manuscripts are to be formatted using A4-size paper (210 mm x 297 mm), single-spaced except for headings and subheadings. The preferred font of text is Times New Roman -10 point (shown here), or as close a match as possible. Full justification should be used when available. Bold should be used for the paper title and major headings. Use a two-column format as this template except title, author(s), affiliation(s), summary, and keyword(s). Each column is 80 mm wide with spacing of 10 mm between columns (total width is 170 mm). All the margins are to be 25 mm including the title page.

SUBMISSION AND NOTIFICATION OF ABSTRACT

Deadline of Abstract

You should submit your abstract on the conference web site

from June 1 to **July 31**. Late submission is not permitted.

Review and Notification

The submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the Program Committee, and then the corresponding author will be advised when the paper is not fitted with the principle of this conference,

PREPARATION OF MANUSCRIPT

Manuscript length and volume limits

Abstracts are specified to **two (2) A4-pages** (including all figures) and **2 MB in a file size**.

Title block

The title should appear in **BOLD CAPITAL LETTERS** with **12 pt. of Times New Roman** centered across both columns without underlining. Type the author's name and affiliation in upper and lower case letters, centered and double-spaced below the title. For multiple organizations, use superscripted numbers to identify organization and list the organizations after the author list.

Headings

Major captions (headings) are to be in capitals without underlining, centered over one column and bold. Subheadings should start at the left-hand margin on separate lines. A blank line space should be placed both before and after each heading or subheading. There should be no blank line after the title of the sections. Sub caption begins with the upper case. If you use sub-sub captions, please type it with normal plain letters. The fonts of text should be **Times New Roman of 10 pt.** in size with single line spacing. At the beginning of each paragraph please indent as on this document.

Equations

Equations are to be numbered consecutively throughout the paper. The equation number, in parentheses, should be placed flush with the right-hand margin of the column. When possible, use an equation editor.

$$E = mc^2 \quad (1)$$

Leave a blank line before and after equations.

References

References are to be listed and numbered at the end of the paper with a left-justified format. The text which refers the references should show them as [1]. Titles of journals and books should be written in *Italic* script. If *italic* script is not available, titles may be bold. Volume numbers in references should be typed in bold. A blank line should be used to separate references in lists as follows:

Illustrations and graphics

Hand-written lettering on figures is not acceptable. The use of **color** in figures and photos is recommended but please keep in mind that total file size never exceeds 2 MB.

Figures and tables should be identified by Arabic numerals and positioned within the text. Illustrations and graphics may be one- or two-columns wide and should include captions or titles.

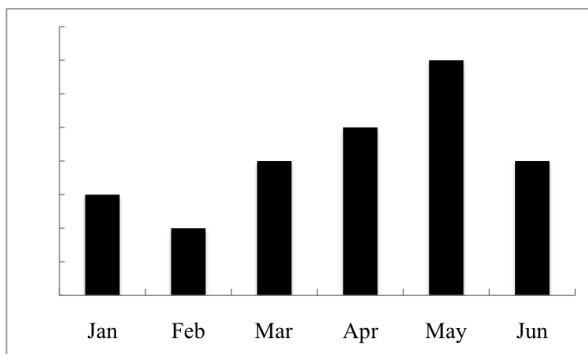


Figure 2. Solar energy irradiation

If possible, the table data should be centered within a single column. If there is not enough space left on the page to allow for your table, end your page and continue on the next page.

The copyright of Abstract belongs to Author, while the full report belongs to Organizer because of uploading to J-Stage .

PRESENTATION POWER POINT

Power Point in presentation can be downloaded by all registered participants. Therefore, presenters are better to omit the secret material from the PPT. It does not matter even if the PPT used in the presentation site is different a bit from the one.

FINAL NOTES

Correction of the abstract after submission

Correction of papers after submission is possible by mid. of July using own page, so called Mypage.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT

Thank you for submitting your abstract. We are eagerly looking forward to seeing all of you at the conference.

Note that those who want to submit to J-Stage are required to submit four-page full paper based on this abstract, regardless of oral or poster by the end of conference finish, December 18, 2026. Format is same as ABSTRACT.
